The Modern Japanese Studies Program (MJSP) is a 4-year bachelor's degree program preceded by a 6-month Intensive Japanese Course (IJC) for those without sufficient Japanese to enter the bachelor's degree program directly. MJSP gives a comprehensive education in the language and society of Japan. For the first 2-3 years courses in the humanities and social sciences are taught in English alongside intensive study of the Japanese Language. After students reach a certain level in Japanese, they will be able to take courses in Japanese in the faculties of Letter, Law, Economics, and Education.



Four Main Characteristics:

- 1) Intensive Study of the Japanese Language
- 2) A Flexible Curriculum in History, Cultural Studies, Sociology, and Political Economy and Subjects in Humanities and Social Sciences
- 3) 20 Students per Year
- 4) Co-Learning with Japanese Students

Year 1

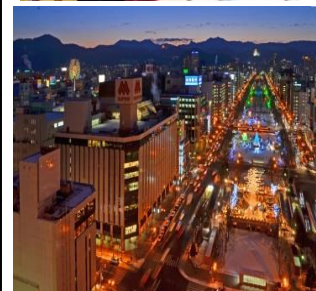
- We will waive the entire enrollment and tuition fees in 2018 for the first year of the bachelor's degree program. [JPY 535,800/year (USD4,674/year)]

- We will waive all, or half of the tuition fees for selected students based on academic performance.
